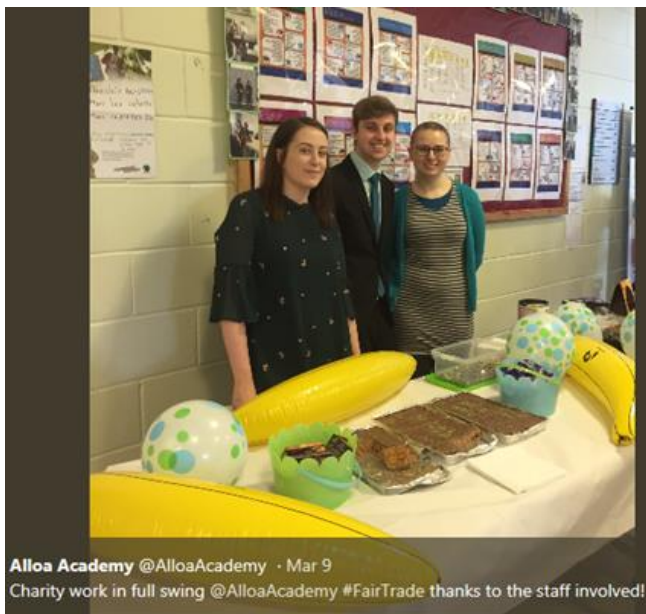

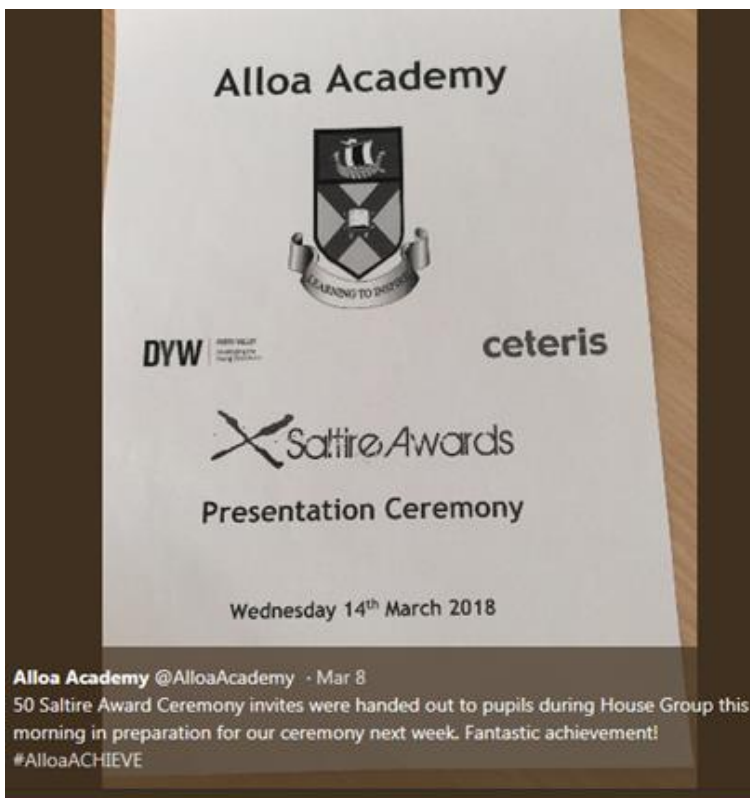
Fair Trade charity work was taking place on Friday and the pupils loved the tasty snacks on offer.
